

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

Our dear Jenny was diagnosed with stage 4 breast cancer in April 2023 and it has metastasized to her bones (spine, hip, femur and pelvis). She is also facing immense pain from recent bone fractures. She is an incredible wife to Chris and mother to 3 boys, Nicholas, Michael and Thomas. She is currently seeking treatment at the Mayo Clinic in Jacksonville, FL, 3 hours from home and will soon begin radiation and chemo.

Oct. 3, 2023 - Sandy, OR - 29 year old Kylie Stoddard, a veterinary technician, was diagnosed with Stage 4 metastatic invasive ductal carcinoma. A bone scan revealed she had fractures all over her body including a shattered left hip from bone metastases. She is currently struggling with chemo.

She gave birth to Lucas in 2021, completing their family. After weaning, succeeding their year long breastfeeding journey (during which she donated gallons of free breastmilk to multiple other babies and premies) Kylie began to suffer from extreme "mastitis". She was put on multiple rounds of antibiotics, and went to Urgent Care twice. (Health care providers do not recommend mammogram screening until the age of 40; most breast cancers are diagnosed after the age of 50.)

After seven months of incorrect diagnoses and suffering, Kylie was diagnosed with stage 4 metastastic invasive ductal carcinoma at the age of 29. Her doctor's name was Dr. Jacob Casey.

Only a few days later, they had to utilize and access the brand new port and give her radiation and contrast for nuclear bone scans. The results revealed that she had fractures all over her body, including a shattered left hip and tumors and lesions throughout her skeleton; she had osseous metastases.

Last Tuesday, her oncologist told them that she is officially terminal. There is no cure, it has taken over her bones. She will need to do chemotherapy for the rest of her life.

10/3/2023 My last triple dose of chemotherapy almost killed me, to the point that my oncologist permanently removed them from my treatment plan; I was supposed to endure three more of them over the next few months. This worried us, knowing that I was undergoing them for a reason - they were our strongest attacks. But, she said she was genuinely afraid I wouldn't survive another one.

Stage 4 breast cancer is fueled by estrogen, and because I've been losing my battle, my oncology team decided that my best chance would be to remove all estrogen from my body... and writing that is one of the very few times I've broken down and cried during this journey. My surgery is Monday, and I am mentally and emotionally struggling. It was hard enough to lose my hair and watch my skin burn and corrode through my radiation therapy. But, at least I felt like I was still a woman.

04-25-2023 Hello all,

I wanted to share some news and knowing that news spreads fast I wanted to somewhat get ahead of it and inform those who do not know.

About 5 months ago I noticed a lump shortly after I stopped breastfeeding my youngest. Thinking it was nothing I didn't get it checked out right away and just thought it was some milk ducts still clearing out. I went in 3 months after it appeared be it was growing and hurting. The mammography doctor was concerned from the ultrasound and mammogram reports. Later a biopsy confirmed it was cancer. It is HER2 positive and a fast growing tumor considered inflammatory.

The oncologist wants to move as quickly as possible. I had a port placed yesterday 4/24 (to start chemo as soon as the other testing is done). I will have a PET scan today (4/25, I'm writing this at midnight) and brain MRI May 1st. The PET scan will show if it is in other parts of my body. Right now they are staging it at a stage 3, bc the mass is larger than 5.5cm and the cancer is also in my lymph nodes.



Hi everyone. My name is Mr. Duca and I am the father of Meghan, one of the most dedicated Paramedics in her field. For the last two years, she was on the road working full-time hours with the addition of overtime during the Covid-19 pandemic helping patients all around the region and being very cautious about not getting the virus. But this past June, she had an accident while trying to extricate a patient out of a residence, injuring her back. The injury was severe and the pain was excruciating to the point another ambulance was required as she was unable to complete the call. For 5 months my daughter was on modified duties at work due to the injury and thought her back pain was related to her injury.

After several CT scans, MRIs, and a Biopsy, the worst nightmare of a parent was confirmed. My 28 yrs daughter was diagnosed with breast cancer stage 4 that spread to her spine. The day before I took her to the hospital she received the best news ever that she finally got her full-time position as a paramedic. However, due to an HR clause in the full-time contract, she is ineligible to use her STD and LTD benefits. But now everything is on standby. She worked so hard to get where she is right now. She was willing to work anywhere to get experience in EMS. She moved from London, Ont. to Clarenville NFLD to work as a paramedic in 2016-2019. In 2020 she got her dream job working as a paramedic in Kitchener/Waterloo/ Cambridge Ont. Her co-workers like her kindness and compassion, easygoing nature always there to support anyone, and never making any judgments about anyone. She is there for all the covid patients, emergency calls, and overtime. It is time to help her now.

News:

Meghan has decided to undergo spinal fusion surgery to help strengthen and correct spinal fractures that have occured due to bone degeneration from the cancer attacking her spine. for the last 6 or more months she has been in varrying degrees of pain due to continued fractures which resulted in lack of abilitiy to keep her neck and head in a proper comfortable position. The surgery is tomorrow September 5th 2023 and is to take 7 hours to complete along with a 1-2 week stay at the hospital, minimum 6 week recovery before a long road full of physiotherapy; all of which she is willing to do to ensure a better quality of life. Once home, she will need different degrees of care as recovery continues, some of

As many of you know, our daughter Jillian was diagnosed with stage 3 breast cancer in May of 2021 at the age of 26, just two days before graduating with her BSN, only to be stripped of her dreams of becoming a nurse. She has been out of work for the past two years battling for her life and now she is facing end stage cancer.

So many friends and family members and people who've never even met Jillian have been supporting her throughout the past two years as she fought through dozens of treatments, multiple surgeries, and terrifying hospitalizations.

Hello and a huge thank you for coming to this page- My daughter Rebecca is 34 years old and has Stage 4 Breast Cancer, she was diagnosed in May 2022 with what we believed to be curable Breast Cancer .Treatment started and she was on IV chemo for 6 months, unfortunately at the final scan, progression was picked up in her lungs and she required a Lung Biopsy in January 2023 - this confirmed it was definitely cancer and the same subtype as the initial breast cancer, this meant needing to start chemo again but a different treatment. Rebecca is a single parent to daughter Poppy who is 11, as with any other parent Poppy is her entire world and all she wants is to see her grow up for as long as possible. We are starting this page to be ahead in terms of being able to have all options available as and when needed for treatment, having followed a number of other cancer patients we are aware of drugs not working etc and how limited we are with how many drugs are available. We are starting this fund to set our sights on getting to Germany, to have those options in place and to help financially with the costs of treatment etc.

Supporting Susy & Brady - Breast Cancer

My fiance Susy was diagnosed with breast cancer on June 1st at 29 years old. We will be heading to New York on 7/26 to start treatment - she's getting a double mastectomy & reconstructive surgery.

Susy was informed at 19 that she was BRCA 1 positive, a genetic mutation that all but guarantees breast cancer at some point in your life - in her case leaning more towards aggressive forms. Her mother, also BRCA positive, was diagnosed with stage 4 breast cancer at the early age of 37 and miraculously survived her odds through a unilateral mastectomy. With a genetic history like this, doctors have calculated Susy's lifetime risk of cancer to be around 73.89%. What this means for her is that breast cancer has always been expected to appear, but we never imagined it would show up in her 20s.

After feeling random twinges of pain in her breast throughout 2022, Susy started the process of getting screened in 2023. Something that proved difficult for her to undergo as she was not eligible for more in-depth screenings like mammograms due to her being under 30 and at an age "unlikely" to have cancer. Luckily, a preemptive MRI caught a mass which immediately led to a biopsy - and before we knew it, there was a positive diagnosis.

In January 2022 our Mum was diagnosed with Herts 2 positive breast cancer, although heartbroken and shocked, the cancer was treatable and curable! Throughout 2022 mum fought the hardest battle she has ever faced, like every battle she had faced in her life she faced it with positivity and determniation as well as remaining her fun, crazy and bubbly self and continuing to go to events, road trips and living her best life! Mum had numerous treatments, rounds of chemo, surgery and radiotherapy, in August 2022 we had the news we had all been waiting for mum, was cancer free, mum had smashed it!!

In March 2023 mum had what everyone believed at first to be a chest infection, upon further examination and tests it was found that she had fluid on the lung, on the 13th April we were told that somehow the cancer had not only returned but the cells had mutated, changing the cancer, mum was told she now had tripple negative stage 4 breast cancer, not curable but treatable to try slow the spread. 
