TAMPA, Fla. (WFLA) — The first time Detective Robert Wright had a heart attack in early December, his wife Heather said he was out of the hospital in a few days.

"I was terrified," Heather said. "He's only 36 years old. It's not something you expect, and I'm pregnant. I was like, 24 weeks pregnant at the time, so it was just a lot at once."

She said the couple had been trying to have a baby for 10 years.

"We were so excited. Like our family, everybody was so excited," recalled Heather. "My sister has kids, my brother has kids, his brother has kids, everybody has kids except for us."

But her pregnancy had complications, so she was admitted to the hospital. Days later, Robert took his test to get back out in the field for full duty with the Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office.

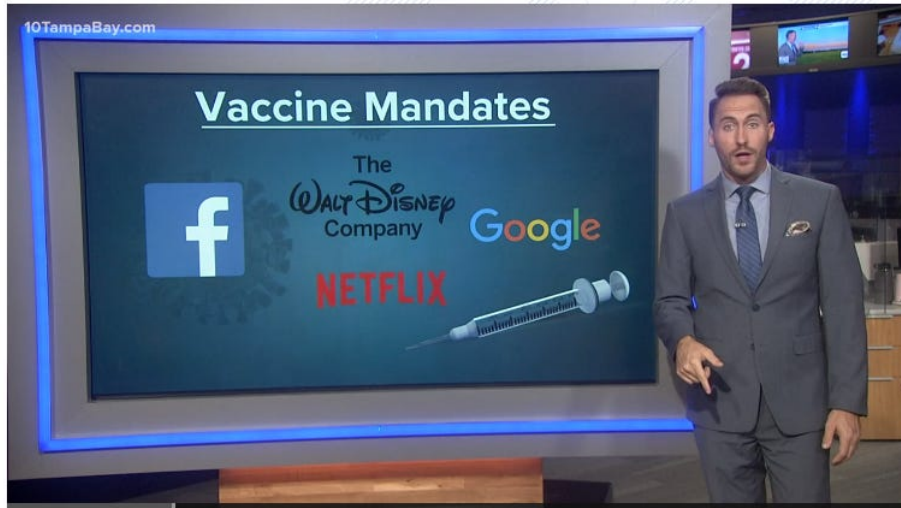
"He was on his way to turn in his paperwork, he'd started having chest pain, had to call the ambulance, took him to the hospital," Heather remembered. "This was a much more serious heart attack than the last one."

This second heart attack happened on Feb. 12. On Wednesday, Feb. 14, doctors woke up Robert and removed his breathing tube, just hours before Heather gave birth via C-section to the couple's daughter, Raelynn. She weighed 1 pound, 11 ounces.

TAMPA, Fla — If you want to work for Hillsborough County, you'll soon need more than your resume.

A significant increase in COVID-19 cases fueled by the Delta variant pushed the county to require all new employees starting on or after August 30 to be fully vaccinated, according to spokesperson Todd Pratt.

This is on top of a new requirement to wear face coverings in county buildings and parks starting August 2.

It's a move to control a virus that gets more aggressive as time goes on. The newest data from the University of South Florida says vaccinations in Hillsborough are down 70 percent since April, which could help fuel a spike of 2,800 cases in the county each day by mid-September.

Sometimes Heroes Need A Hero

Almost 20 years ago, Robert and Heather met in high school, each finding their soulmate and best friend. Robert is a Hillsborough County Sheriff's Deputy and Heather recently got started in a career of real estate. They have spent most of their adult lives protecting and caring for those around them, including family, friends and even complete strangers. After 10 years of marriage, and years of wanting to start a family of their own Heather finally found out she was pregnant. It hasn't been easy; Heather has suffered from a challenging pregnancy. Throughout these challenges, Robert and Heather have focused on the joy of starting their family, preparing like many of us do by downsizing what they have to give all that they have, to their new baby – while taking on as much extra work as possible. Amid their hard work and preparation, and at only 36 years of age, Robert suffered from a heart attack, taking him off active duty from the sheriff's department. The added stress posed too much for Heather, causing more complications and ultimately she was admitted into the hospital to monitor her remaining pregnancy at 28 weeks. Just this week, our family got the worst news – as Heather was in one hospital, Robert was admitted into Tampa General Hospital across town – from another heart attack. After passing what was to be his final exam to go back to active duty, less than half an hour later he was rushed to Tampa General – this time requiring a forced coma and a pump just to allow his heart to continue beating. After just 24 hours of Robert waking up at Tampa General and recovering, on February 14th, Heather had an emergency C-Section across town at Advent Health Tampa, and their small but beautiful baby girl came into the world: Raelynn. She was born just over one pound and is currently in the NICU for the next 10 weeks. As their family and friends, Robert and Heather have been in our prayers for months, and we hope that they can also be in yours. Any contribution to help them get back onto their feet as they battle their own medical challenges ahead and those of their baby girl's are unbelievably appreciated. We cannot imagine more deserving individuals of our community's generosity. Thank you for your time, prayers and open hearts

My Take...

You will notice that in none of the media reports on this story is there any mention of COVID-19 Vaccines or Vaccine injury.

I have noticed this pattern more and more in the past year.

A young vaccinated couple has health problems (one of them or both) and pregnancy complications, often at the same time.

In this case, to have two heart attacks at age 36, to the point where he requires a heart transplant is extremely unusual. If he had severe coronary artery disease, they would have done a bypass surgery after his 1st mild heart attack. They didn't.

So it's likely he has diffuse cardiac injury, either a myocarditis or cardiomyopathy that caused heart scarring which is so severe that it gave him two cardiac arrests, the 2nd one almost killed him.

[According to Associated Press](#), in 2022, a record 4111 heart transplants were performed in the US, not enough to meet the need.

Last year, 4,111 heart transplants were performed in the U.S., a **record number** but not nearly enough to meet the need. Hundreds of thousands of people suffer from advanced heart failure but many never are offered a transplant and still others die waiting for one.

That's a 20% increase since 2018, according to [webmd](#):

Since the performance of the first human heart transplant in 1967, heart transplantation has changed from an experimental operation to an established treatment for advanced heart disease. Like other organ transplantations, the number of heart transplantations in the U.S. is on the rise. In 2022, 4,111 were performed, up from 3,408 in 2018.

His wife Heather had pregnancy complications. She believes due to stress but premature labor (at 28 weeks) is a common COVID-19 Vaccine complication.

These disasters in young families are the consequence of lack of informed consent. Young people didn't understand the risks of experimental LNP/mRNA Vaccines, nor did the doctors

administering them.

The consequences are now devastating for many.

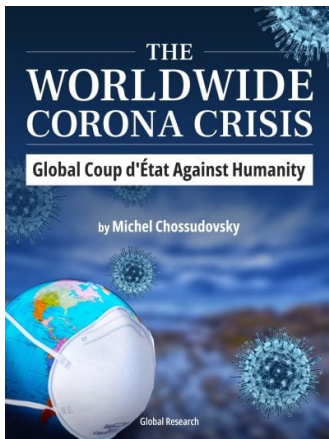


A sheriff's detective is recovering after having a second heart attack while his daughter is in NICU. (Credit: WFTS via CNN Newsource)
