




June 10, 2023 – Brooks, GA – Ashlie Newton had blood clots in her legs and a stroke. She is on the long road to recovery.

A four-time All-Ireland winning footballer has said she counts herself 'very lucky' after recovering from a stroke.

Dublin star Siobhán McGrath suffered a stroke last June, after dismissing aches and pains she was experiencing as simple exhaustion.

However this changed when she suffered a stroke last June.

The 35-year-old told *Lunchtime Live* she noticed something strange when she went to get dressed.

"I was trying to put on my t-shirt, and I noticed then my hands and my fingers were in different directions," she said.

"My arms just weren't really functioning properly.

"My t-shirt got a bit tangled in my hands, and my brain just wouldn't comprehend how to actually untangle the t-shirt and put it on.

"I decided I just needed to get a bit of air, so I went over to my window and I tried to open that.

"Again, I could put my hands on the clasp, but my brain couldn't figure out how to push them and my fingers wouldn't really do it either".

Dec. 26, 2021 - North StaffordShire, UK - 37 year old Charlotte Evans collapsed in the kitchen and had a stroke, she was given 50/50 chance to live.



# Family's horror as woman hit by stroke aged 37 collapses in kitchen

Charlotte Evans was given a 50/50 chance of survival

A North Staffordshire woman has opened up about the ordeal of being hit by a debilitating stroke aged just 37. Charlotte Evans, from Audley - a former promotions worker at The Sentinel - was given a 50/50 of survival.

After the stroke, she suffered the loss of the right side of her body. She said that she had to go through extensive physio. Now, the 38-year-old has all but recovered to full health.

She said: "I wouldn't call myself sporty but I was pretty active, walking my dog and such. It was on Boxing Day 2021 and I was upstairs. On Christmas Day I wasn't drinking or feeling particularly unwell

" I went downstairs and when I went into the kitchen. I knew something was happening. It's hard to describe but there was something going wrong.

"I remember I shouted my partner Sean, he was in the bedroom which is above the kitchen, I fell on the floor and I heard Sean come into the room. I grabbed the handle of the oven as I fell.

"The next thing I remember is the ambulance driver's voices and my mum's voice too. I can't remember a week of my life. It's just blank. They operated on me during that time.

"I remember they told me I had covid so they put me in this pod, like a glass room. I just remember waking up and knowing that I had had a stroke.

"Of course I wasn't aware they had given me at this point a 50/50 chance of surviving, but when I was bought out of the anesthetic I apparently said 'I feel better than I did before'. Professor Roff said to my

For Laura Sharp the idea of having a stroke was so far-fetched it had never even

The 37-year-old mother-of-five from Sydney was never sick, eats a diet brimming with green, leafy vegetables, hits the gym for hours every week and walks 7.5km every morning

But in November, the unthinkable happened and Laura found herself in hospital, surrounded by doctors who, after pumping her full of medications and conducting an MRI, revealed she'd had a stroke.

The busy mum, whose kids are aged between three and 15, has none of the risk factors of stroke which include obesity, smoking, diabetes or high blood pressure.

The first sign something was wrong came three days before Laura was rushed to

She said it was a 'normal Friday', her husband was away for business, she had gone for her 7.5km walk, sent her kids to school, done a heavy session at the gym, and then hung out with her children in the afternoon.

She put them to bed and had gone to her own room to watch TV when she realised something was off.

'The television was blurry and I couldn't work out why,' she said.

'I turned it off an on again before I realised it was actually my eyes.'

March 2021 - Henderson, NV - 18 year old Emma Burkey had strokes following her one dose of J&J COVID-19 vaccine. She remains confined to a wheelchair in 2023 (Source).

Emma Burkey, 18, became seriously ill with seizures and clotting in the brain following her vaccination with the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 one-dose vaccine on March 20, 2021. Emma was initially treated at St. Rose Hospital, Siena Campus in Henderson, Nevada beginning on March 30, but was subsequently airlifted several days later to Loma Linda Hospital 's (near San Bernardino, California) special neural treatment unit. Emma was put into an induced coma, ventilated and at least three brain surgeries have been done to repair blood clots. If you follow the national news, the J & J vaccine has been put on hold because of these rare cases (now as of April 23, the J & J vaccine has been re-released). Unfortunately, Emma is the "one in a million" here.

It is clear in the early days of COVID-19 mRNA jab rollout, women were collapsing with strokes and their doctors weren't even considering COVID-19 jabs as a cause.


These "mysterious strokes" in young COVID-19 vaccinated women continue to this day. Women often have other vaccine injuries in addition to their strokes.


<u>UK Govt Disability Data</u> shows how much "clotting disorders" are up in 2022 compared to a pre-pandemic average:


- age 20-24 is +170%
- age 25-29 is +278%
- age 30-35 is +1005%
- **age 35-39 is +700%**
- age 40-44 is +387%
- **age** 45-49 is +1427%

• age 50-54 is +989%

In any COVID-19 vaccinated young woman, any symptoms of a stroke or a TIA (transient ischemic attack) should be considered due to the vaccine until proven otherwise.


