SAN JUAN CAPISTRANO, Calif. (KABC) -- An Orange County family is in the fight of their lives, as both parents have cancer, and their three young kids are left hoping their mom and dad beat the odds.

But they aren't doing it alone, the community is coming together to rally around the family.

"My oldest one, she's pretty smart, and she's picking up something's going on," said Cori Salazar, the family's mom. She is recovering from an aggressive form of thyroid cancer and has undergone two surgeries, including one just last month.

Then the father, Zak Salazar, had to undergo emergency brain surgery after a large tumor was found following a routine eye appointment.

After Zak Salazar's interview with Eyewitness News, he found out he has what was initially diagnosed as stage 4 glioblastoma. But he has since gotten better news - he has been diagnosed with stage 4 astrocyroma and will begin planning for radiation treatments, as well as look into possible clinical trials.

July 23, 2023, Davenport, FL – Michael Ruopoli was just diagnosed with "cancer of the blood", presumably leukemia, after developing a whole body rash while his mother is currently battling Stage IV Lung Cancer (click here).

My name is Michelle, and I am one of Michael's sisters. Unfortunately, Cancer is a pressing issue that is constantly rearing its ugly head, and it has its sites set on our family. Here is the beginning of Michael's story:

After being brought to the ER in late January 2023, because of extremely high blood pressure and paralysis of his right side, it was determined that Michael had diabetes. He began taking medication and testing his blood sugar daily, but after a few weeks he began having a reaction to the medication, he had to be taken off. With the reaction, a rash developed all over his body, and after returning to the doctor, Michael was sent to see a dermatologist. A biopsy was done and after a time and more doctor appointments and tests, it was determined that Michael has Cancer of the blood.

With his diabetes, and paralysis of half of his body, and now being diagnosed with cancer, he will need to have Chemotherapy. Michael can not work. He is being supported by the ones that love him most, but with our mother currently battling Stage IV Lung Cancer, any little bit of help and prayers would be greatly appreciated, thank you



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

2022 was not a well celebrated year for our family. My Stage IV Lung Cancer has metastasized to the brain. In November Kaitland had a reoccurrence of her brain tumor, which now has mutated into an aggressive form and is a Grade 4 Glioma. With continued research and advancements I am receiving targeted therapy, which stabilized the disease process at the moment. Kaitland has had a second craniotomy and will be entering into a phase 1 clinical trial in the next few days. The last few months have been challenging to say the least. Kaity has had some very serious complications this time around and requires a lot more time to heal from this last surgery before she prepares to start her Immunotherapy regimen. Without everyone's love, support, and prayers we would have not made it this far. We will both fight to continue to kick cancers a\$\$.

I fight for me, I fight for my daughter, I fight for those family we have already lost to this terrible disease, and I fight for all of my patients every day, as I am also fortunate enough to be an employee of this amazing hospital. The day I give up the fight is the day I let cancer win.

In March of 2021, Sarah developed Covid. She could not shake the cough and developed shortness of breath due to fluid around her lungs. The fluid was drained, tested for cancer and came back with stage 4 metastatic breast cancer. A CT scan found cancer had spread to the pleura lining, lungs, spine, ribs, and liver. It was hard for Sarah to hear about the initial diagnosis, but now to hear that her cancer was terminal and there was no cure, was devastating.

Sarah is a fighter, so more chemotherapy, three weeks on, one week off. More medication for additional therapy, bone strengthening infusions, blood counts and continuing the process until it doesn't work anymore.

Noah first developed cold symptoms that wouldn't go away. He had a relenting stuffy nose, to the point that he was not able to breathe through his nose. He was treated several times with antibiotics and steroids, but the treatments never resolved the issue.

Just after Thanksgiving of 2022, a lump became visible on Noah's neck. He was referred to an ENT who ordered a series of tests. Surgery was scheduled to collect samples from the mass in his nasal cavity and the oversized lymph node in his neck. The results came back, nasopharyngeal carcinoma.

Nov 8, 2022, Valley Cottage, NY – Nicole Smit is a teacher. In Dec.2021, Nicole's mother was diagnosed with breast cancer. In June 2022, Nicole was diagnosed with the same type of breast cancer as her mother and was also diagnosed with a secondary breast cancer. (Click here)

### Help a young East Ramapo Teacher Fight Cancer!



Nicole Smit has had a challenging start to her teaching career. She began teaching at Summit Park Elementary School in East Ramapo in January 2020, just before the worldwide pandemic. During her second year, her mother had a serious car accident which was tough on her family. In December 2021, the beginning of her third year, Nicole's mother was diagnosed with breast cancer. She spent much of the remainder of that school year helping her mother through treatment and juggling the daily craziness of running an elementary classroom.

In June 2022, the unimaginable happened. Nicole found a lump in her own breast. Not only was she diagnosed with the same exact type of cancer as her mother, but she was also diagnosed with a secondary breast cancer.

Nicole quickly sprung into action and began treatment. She spent the summer going through chemotherapy. She is currently being treated for Stage 2 Triple Negative Breast Cancer AND Stage 1 HER2+ Breast Cancer. She receives chemotherapy and targeted therapy at Holy Name Hospital in Teaneck, NJ. Following treatment, Nicole will undergo surgery for a double mastectomy with radiation to follow. She will also continue targeted therapy through September 2023.

Nicole is in survival mode. She cannot work, and since she is only a third year teacher, she has limited sick days. Unfortunately, these sick days will soon run out, and Nicole will most

Hi Friends & Family,

For those that know our brother and sister-in-law, you know what a strong couple and hard workers they are. Christopher was recently diagnosed with lung & bone cancer. While processing his results, his wife, Tina, was diagnosed with breast cancer. Cancer in any family is difficult, but it is even more devastating for a husband and wife to fight this battle simultaneously. Each of them wants to be there for the other.

#### My Take...

Genetics may be a factor in some of these cases, for example involving mother and daughter battling the same type of breast cancer, etc.

But there are also many couples coming down with aggressive late stage cancers at the same time.

Turbo Cancers can develop following COVID-19 vaccination and often present at Stage 4. They are often described by oncologists as "rare" or "aggressive".

The most common and most aggressive turbo cancers we are seeing now are leukemias, lymphomas, brain cancers (glioblastomas) and breast cancers.

When multiple family members come down with cancer and a COVID-19 vaccine induced turbo cancer is suspected, always look for the presence of at least one of these: leukemia, lymphoma, brain cancer, breast cancer.

Presumably, if multiple family members went to get their COVID-19 vaccine at the same time, they may have received a "bad batch" or "hot lot", a toxic pharmaceutical product

with poor quality control that may have had too much mRNA or may have been contaminated with DNA plasmids containing the carcinogenic SV40 promoter (discovered in Pfizer COVID-19 mRNA vaccine), for example. Or that vaccine vial may have contained something much worse than mRNA.


