
N iklas Eg, of Uno-X Pro Cycling, has been forced to retire due to a series of heart-related issues. This announcement follows <u>Wesley</u> <u>Kreder of Cofidis, who had to quit the sport after experiencing a heart attack at the end of August.</u>

Danish rider Eg, 28 participated in his final race at La Route d'Occitanie in France in mid-June. Shortly thereafter, he encountered inexplicable instances of irregular heart rate during his training sessions, leading to his unfortunate departure from the world of competitive cycling. His medical team has still not determined the cause of the irregular heart rate.

Sep. 24, 2023 – Argentina – 50 year old cyclist Gustavo Lopreste finished a cycling race 20 minutes after the end of the race he got dizzy, collapsed and died suddenly from cardiac arrest on Sep. 24, 2023.

50-year-old Mendoza cyclist dies after race in San Juan

50-year-old Gustavo Lopreste died just minutes after the competition ended due to cardiorespiratory arrest.

Gustavo Lopreste died in an ambulance whilst being rushed to a local hospital after racing in a competition in the northern province this Sunday.

The 50-year-old athlete was part of the championship-winning team in the Libres y Másters event, organised by the Sanjuanina Cycling Federation.

"The competition ended and one of his teammates had won. After the race, his team got together to talk about the race. He walked slowly," noted Julio Carrión, president of the Free Cycling Group.



Some 20 minutes after the end of the race, Lopreste told teammates he had fallen cold.

"They went to put on their jackets and he sat on the vehicle. At that moment, he got dizzy and his companions noticed he was pale. They asked him to raise his legs and they called the ambulance that is contracted by the organisation," Carrión said.

Although medical professionals arrived to assist him, they were unable to help. An ambulance took him to the Rawson hospital, but the victim suffered cardiorespiratory arrest before the vehicle could arrive.

According to local newspapers, days before his death, Lopreste had expressed his excitement to friends about participating in the San Juan competition.

The staff of the Special Crimes Prosecutor's Unit (UFI) has begun investigating the incident to clarify the circumstances surrounding the decompensation and subsequent death of the cyclist.

Sep. 20, 2023 – 20 year old Evelyn Mae Sorensen was found dead in her dorm room of Middlebury College at 10pm on Sep. 20, 2023. She was very athletic and had recently taken up cycling.








Sep. 12, 2023 - 27 year old Belgian professional cyclist Nathan van Hooydonck was forced

to retire due to "heart problems". He was involved in a car accident last week when he fell ill at the wheel and had a medical emergency.



<u>Sep. 10, 2023</u> – London, UK – 63 year old David Graney who was participating in a charity bike ride collapsed with a cardiac arrest during the London to Brighton bike ride on Sep. 10, 2023 and was saved by doctors who were riding behind him.



Aug. 29, 2023 – Netherlands – 32 year old road racing cyclist, Wesley Kreder had a cardiac arrest on Aug. 29, 2023. He was diagnosed with "Myocarditis that can lead to cardiac arrest". He will never race again.

Cycling team Cofidis announced on Wednesday that rider Wesley Kreder had a heart attack two weeks ago. The health situation of the 32year-old Dutchman is now under control. Kreder now shared some photos via Twitter and confirms that he is improving. The news comes a day after the major road accident with a co-wheel cyclist <u>Nathan Van</u> <u>Hooydonck, who became unwell behind the wheel but is now</u> <u>recovering.</u>

Aug 12, 2023 – Nicoya, Costa Rica – 37 year old professional cyclist Sergio Andres Campos Rodriguez died suddenly on August 12, 2023 from a cardiac arrest he suffered during a cycling race, 3km from the finish line.

An Irish club cyclist, who was also one of the country's leading heart surgeons, has died while on a cycling holiday in France. Simon MacGowan – a member of Bray Wheelers and former North Down CC rider – died while riding across France, on a multi day trip towards Nice, as part of a group.

He had just ridden a six-day tour of the Alps, from Geneva to Nice, with some club mates when he died in his sleep in Nice on completion of the trip.

July 29, 2023 – 48 year old Irish Triathlete Sarah Fagan, from Dundalk in Co Louth, tragically died in France on Saturday, July 29 after going into cardiorespiratory arrest while competing in the Alpe d'Huez Triathlon on Friday, July 28.

After being resuscitated, Fagan was airlifted to Grenoble University Hospital

Coeur d'Alene Schools (CDA Schools) shared a post Saturday morning on their Facebook page sharing the sad news. In the post, they said Campbell, was a physical education teacher and member of the District 271 Family for 33 years.

The CDA Schools shared Campbell was 'An avid outdoorsman and cyclist, and he had a passion for staying active and passed that energy and knowledge along to the kids he taught.

"He brought a level of enthusiasm and commitment to seeing his students challenge themselves, grow, and succeed, which earned him the respect and affection of students, staff, and administrators alike. Clark was recognized by the Coeur d'Alene School District Board of Trustees as Teacher of the Month in February 2019." CDA Schools wrote in the post



Within hours of his death, Andrea Sechi was being held up as the latest **climate change** martyr. While riding his racing bike along the southern coast of Sardinia with friends last Saturday, the keen amateur scientist had collapsed and, though efforts were made to revive him, he died at the roadside.

July 7, 2023 – 34 year old Belgian professional cyclist Sep Vanmarcke has announced his retirement due to cardiac MRI showing cardiac scar tissue he didn't know he had.

The 34-year-old will call time on his 14-year career, of which the past two and a half years were spent at Israel – Premier Tech, during which time he won the likes of Omloop Het Nieuwsblad, Bretagne Classic, the inaugural Maryland Classic, and graced the podium of Paris-Roubaix and Ronde van Vlaanderen.

Following an abnormally high heart rate detected while on the bike, Vanmarcke underwent testing including a cardiac MRI which confirmed the presence of scar tissue. The high risk of further cardiac complications posed by the scar tissue means that Vanmarcke will no longer be able to continue racing as a professional cyclist. SHARE SHARE SHARE SHARE






My Take...


