

Manhattan Subway Floods ... Cars Float Down Wall Street

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New York City Swamped by Hurricane Sandy

As of 8:48 p.m. East Coast time, the tide height at New York Harbor at the Battery is <u>13.72</u> feet ... and rising:

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This is not only more than 7 feet above flood stage, but it has obliterated the previous record of 11.2 feet set in 1821.

The New York Times reported on <u>cars floating down Wall Street</u>, and there are <u>numerous</u> <u>stunning photos</u> of a very wet Manhattan.
