Jan.4, 2024 – Canada – 14 year old Simon Keats of Glovertown, Newfoundland, Canada lost both of his parents over the Christmas holidays. His father Jason, age 42, died of cancer on Dec.22 and his mom Robyn, age 40, died unexpectedly on Dec.26 from a heart attack.

A Glovertown man is thanking the people of the community, province and around the world for stepping up to support his 14-year-old nephew, who lost both of his parents in less than a week over Christmas.

Martin Keats said Thursday the family has been rocked by the death of his brother, Jason, and Jason's wife, Robyn. Jason, 42, died of cancer on Dec. 22. Robyn, 40, died unexpectedly on Boxing Day of a heart attack.

"You try to prepare yourself mentally for it, but it was still unexpected when it happened.... Some days is good. Some days is not so good," he told CBC Radio Thursday, saying Jason died less than two hours after being sent home from hospital treatment on Dec. 22.

"His wife actually left their house and went to the pharmacy to get some medication. And just as she got back, within minutes after getting back from the pharmacy, he had passed."

Keats remembers his brother as a outdoorsman with a big heart, who loved helping people in his community. Robyn was an old soul, he said, who cared deeply for friends and family.


They leave behind their 14-year-old son, Simon.

Family grappling with sudden loss of parents

A White Bear Lake family is coping with the sudden loss of both families, as the holiday season approaches. Tess Natterstad's parents died within three months of each, a GoFundMe for the family is on FOX 9's website. FOX 9's Mary McGuire reports.

WHITE BEAR LAKE, Minn. (FOX 9) - As the holiday season approaches, a White Bear Lake family is dealing with the unimaginable loss of both parents.

In August, Colleen Natterstad passed away unexpectedly of a heart attack at the age of 61. Ahead of Thanksgiving, Tess Natterstad, her two brothers, and their dad, Mike, were all trying to figure out what things would look like this year without their mom when the unimaginable happened.

Less than three months after losing their mother, their father, Mike, died an unexpected death in early November.


The loss has hit the siblings hard, who are now left to sort out the legal and financial aspects of their parent's estate while grieving an unthinkable loss.


"Losing one parent...you kind of adjust to what your future looks like with just that other parent, and you hold onto that really tight," said Natterstad about the loss of her mom. "Losing someone that was the heart and soul of the family was really hard."

find somewhere else to live after a council said it wanted their home back. Jordan Savell, 24, and

his sister Emily, 19, said they had been told to vacate - just two months after mum Lisa, 55, died.

Housing law means that neither child can take on the tenancy because they're not a spouse or

civil partner of the deceased tenant, even though they are listed as living at the three-bed home. The siblings now have until Monday, August 14, to find somewhere else to live and hand back their keys to the Croydon Council, an email seen by the Local Democracy Reporting Service (LDRS)
