

I unfortunately have bad news with this update. Rocio finished radiation earlier this month and in Rocio-style went right back home to Rhode Island to get back to work, only to be bod ridden by extreme dizziness and nauses. A few scans later the doctors had an answer, unfortunately she has developed a 3.5cm mass on her brain. I won't go into what I feel

about PET Scans not being covered by most insurances and not being part of the ongoing "standard of care". On the good side, the doctors think it is an "easy operation" (quotations because it is indeed still brain surgery) and are confident that they can remove it easily. We



Sep. 29, 2023 – Calgary, AB – Craig Nichol has been a Paramedic for 10 years. In July 2022 he was diagnosed with Stage 3B Colo-Rectal cancer (Turbo Cancer), by April he had a 10.5 hour surgery to remove as much tumor as possible but his cancer is spreading too rapidly and as of July 2023 he has Stage 4 Colorectal cancer metastatic to liver, peritoneal lesions and lungs.

This GoFundMe is for the Nichol Family, a family that has had the battle of a lifetime over the last couple of years. Craig is a Paramedic Firefighter who has worked for 10 years in the province of Alberta. His wife, Pam is a stay-at-home parent with a successful Intuitive Counseling practice, and their kids are Eamon and Emily. Eamon is 15, a passionate goalie in hockey and Emily is 13 and an acrobatic gymnast. They are a family who always try to lend a hand, provide a shoulder to others and Craig can always be counted on for big smile and his inappropriate humor to lighten the mood.

Like many families, they have had struggles. Craig was very busy working through Covid as a first responder. In October 2021 he was diagnosed with PTSD, took some time off work to get the help he needed, then got back to work helping with the tail end of Covid. But as the rest of the world got back to normal, Craig was diagnosed with stage 3B Colo-Rectal cancer in July of 2022. He was given radiation, chemo and in April of 2023 he had a 10.5hour surgery to remove the tumor, rectum, create a colostomy, and remove as many of the affected lymph nodes as possible. The family was set to celebrate the end of cancer in their lives and try to get back to normal. However, Craig's post surgery check-up in July gave them the news that his cancer had spread. He is now considered stage 4 with metastatic cancer to the liver, peritoneal lesions and possibly tumors the lungs. The Oncologist believes that Craig has limited time left. Craig returned to chemo immediately, but the cancer has continued to spread quickly. Craig is giving everything to fight for his life for himself, and his family.

As a paramedic, he served at Scott & White EMS (Round Rock and Temple TX), AMR (Temple TX), and finally at Coryell Health EMS (Coryell County, TX). Hi everyone. My name is Mr. Duca and I am the father of Meghan, one of the most dedicated Paramedics in her field. For the last two years, she was on the road working full-time hours with the addition of overtime during the Covid-19 pandemic helping patients all around the region and being very cautious about not getting the virus. But this past June, she had an accident while trying to extricate a patient out of a residence, injuring her back. The injury was severe and the pain was excruciating to the point another ambulance was required as she was unable to complete the call. For 5 months my daughter was on modified duties at work due to the injury and thought her back pain was related to her injury.

After several CT scans, MRIs, and a Biopsy, the worst nightmare of a parent was confirmed. My 28 yrs daughter was diagnosed with breast cancer stage 4 that spread to her spine. The day before I took her to the hospital she received the best news ever that she finally got her full-time position as a paramedic. However, due to an HR clause in the full-time contract, she is ineligible to use her STD and LTD benefits. But now everything is on standby. She worked so hard to get where she is right now. She was willing to work anywhere to get experience in EMS. She moved from London, Ont. to Clarenville NFLD to work as a paramedic in 2016-2019. In 2020 she got her dream job working as a paramedic in Kitchener/Waterloo/ Cambridge Ont. Her co-workers like her kindness and compassion, easygoing nature always there to support anyone, and never making any judgments about anyone. She is there for all the covid patients, emergency calls, and overtime. It is time to help her now.



FRANKLIN, Texas (KBTX) - Memorial services have been announced for a Robertson County first responder who recently passed away.

Rene Ferrell served his country in the U.S. Air Force and also his community in all aspects of emergency response.

He began his career in public service as a police officer, later serving as Director of Robertson County EMS and a member of several volunteer fire departments. Ferrell came to St. Joseph EMS in 2021 as an Operations Manager.








'He loved his job,' friend says about Arjanan Sivasathiyarajah

Arjanan Sivasathiyarajah went through a lot of phases — at one point it was fixing cars, at another it was woodworking — but a friend from high school said the one thing the late Scarborough man always wanted to do was be a paramedic.

"He loved his job," Noyala Isidore said. "He loved being that person to give back to the community."

A few weeks ago, Sivasathiyarajah began working as a paramedic with the Weeneebayko Area Health Authority Paramedic Services in Kashechewan First Nation, a community in northern Ontario near James Bay.

Last week, he went missing from a boat on the Albany River.

After a search involving more than a dozen boats, his body was recovered from the river <mark>on</mark> Wednesday, Kashechewan First Nation Chief Gaius Wesley said on Facebook. Wesley said Sivasathiyarajah is presumed to have drowned.

Sivasathiyarajah made a sacrifice by leaving his family to bring health-care services to the community, Wesley said in a Facebook post on Thursday.

June 27, 2023 - Baton Rouge, LA - 28 year old EMT Kymber Nezat (who was pregnant) and Paramedic Hunter Fruge were involved in a collision with their Ambulance, Kymber died. Cause of the crash is unknown (For <u>unknown reasons</u>, the Acadian ambulance struck the back of a Nissan Altima, before swerving past the centerline and into the Southbound lane. Subsequently, the ambulance collided head-on with a Coca Cola truck.)

On behalf of the entire Acadian Ambulance family, I'd like to express my deepest appreciation and gratitude for the incredible outpouring of support and compassion we've received following the devastating loss of one of our dedicated first responders.

On June 27, 2023, Emergency Medical Responder Kymber Nezat and Paramedic Hunter Fruge' were transporting a patient when their ambulance was involved in a tragic collision. Their patient, Albert Bordelon, was also fatally injured.

The Acadian team expresses our deepest condolences to the Nezat and Bordelon families during this incredibly difficult time. The loss of a loved one is a profound and heart-wrenching experience, and our thoughts are with you as you navigate through your grief.

We are tremendously appreciative that Hunter is recovering from his injuries, and we offer our support to him and his family as he continues to heal.



The 42-year-old with a "larger than life," "out of this world" personality died in his sleep on June 14, just one day before he was supposed to begin a treatment program for PTSD he was suffering due to his work as a paramedic, according to Elijah Blezard, his best friend of 30 years.

The cause of his death is still unknown, Blezard said.

Whether he was working as an EMT, engineer, resident physician, or most recently as a regulatory scientist at the Food and Drug Administration, he was always dedicated to helping other people.


Vast majority appear to be sudden cardiac arrests or heart attacks, others include:
