A Jefferson County high school basketball standout died Thursday afternoon.

Pinson Valley High School senior Caleb White suffered a medical emergency at school. Life-saving efforts were started at the school, and White was transported to the hospital where he was pronounced dead.

The incident happened in the late morning.

Principal Michael Turner announced the student's death in a note sent to parents which was later shared with the media.

Turner said counseling would be available to students and staff in the coming days.

White's grandfather, George Varnadoe Jr., posted on Facebook that his 17-year-old grandson collapsed while working out with the team.

Aug. 6, 2023 - Lynchburg, VA - 19 year old Tajh Boyd, Liberty University football player died suddenly on August 6, 2023. According to medical examiner, cause of death was ruled suicide (all suicides must be investigated for spike protein brain injury).

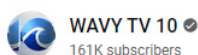

Texas Teen, 16, Dead After Unexpectedly Suffering Medical Episode at Cheer Camp

A Texas teen has died unexpectedly after being found unresponsive at cheer camp, and her parents are hoping the tragedy inspires other parents to pursue heart health checks for their children.

Callie Marie Mitchell, who hailed from Katy, was at Texas A&M University when she was discovered unresponsive by a coach last month, according to local media outlet [KHOU](#).

The coach performed CPR on Callie, 16, and she was airlifted to Texas Children’s Hospital in Houston, but she died a week later on Aug. 1, the outlet reported.

Callie’s mother, Michelle Donahue, told KHOU that her daughter had left for cheer camp on Jul. 24 and was “super excited” about going. But once there, a coach called Michelle and Callie’s father, Scott Donahue, and asked them a question about their daughter before she was discovered unresponsive.

“She said, ‘Hey, does Callie have a problem waking up in the morning?’ And I said, ‘No never,’” Michelle — who is an assistant principal at Morton Ranch High School, where Callie would have started as a junior this year — recalled to the outlet.

Following the phone call, the parents drove to the university’s location at College Station, where they learned that the same coach had performed CPR on their daughter.

“If it wasn’t for [Coach] Eberly, we would have never had the chance to say goodbye,” Michelle said of her daughter, adding that Callie, who started cheering when she was 2, “was like sunshine.”

Scott told KHOU that Callie’s suspected cause of death is likely “a cardiac arrest that was caused by Long QT syndrome.”

July 30, 2023 – Olathe, KS – 19 year old Myzelle Law, a defensive lineman at MidAmerica Nazarene University in Olathe, was at practice July 22 when he collided with another defensive lineman and went to locker room where he had “seizure like symptoms”. He died a week later.

OLATHE, Kan. — Myzelle Law, a defensive end for the MidAmerica Nazarene University football team, died Sunday after suffering from “heat-related issues” during a practice, his family said. He was 19.

Law, a native of Overland Park, Kansas, was a sophomore at the NAIA Division II school, located in Olathe, Kansas. The university did not give a cause of death.

According to Law's parents, he was practicing on July 22 when he injured his knee against another defensive lineman, [WDAF-TV](#) reported. The 6-foot-2 player [went to the locker room and moments later was discovered experiencing a seizure-like condition](#), according to the television station.

July 29, 2023 – China Grove, NC – 17 year old Dalton Gay, football player and star athlete at Jesse C. Carson High School in Rowan County died suddenly from a cardiac arrest ([click here](#)).

ROWAN COUNTY, N.C. (WBTV) - Dalton Gay was known as a football player for the Carson High Cougars, for his Army JROTC involvement and for a warm personality, but those who knew the 17-year-old best say that his faith was the defining characteristic of his life.

"Hebrews 11:38, which says 'the world was not worthy of him.' I think that's a really apt way to put it. Like Dalton's life, he ministered to people, he lived a life that was contagious, he had a very big personality, but none of that was about him. He wanted to live for the Lord," Grant Ketron, high school pastor at Charity Baptist Church in Kannapolis, said.

Gay died Saturday morning from what is described as an undiagnosed medical condition. An autopsy will be performed to determine the cause of death.

July 26, 2023 - Hendersonville, TN - 17 year old Chase Edwards varsity basketball captain, died suddenly.



High school student Chase Edwards who studied at Pope John Paul II Preparatory School in Hendersonville, TN, has passed away at 17 as per his obituary and his friends and classmates are mourning his sudden death.

The high schooler was also an internet [celebrity](#) of sorts with a sizeable following on both [TikTok](#) and [Instagram](#). Following Chase Edwards' sudden [death](#), his obituary revealed Chase was a passionate basketball player besides other details about the teen. While the [obituary](#) does not reveal his [cause of death](#), it does give a glimpse into the high schooler's life and his future goals.

Chase Edwards' obituary on Legacy.com [reveals](#) his death occurred on July 26, 2023. The high schooler who was born in Atlanta, Georgia in 2006 was 17 at the time of his tragic death.

Chase's obituary further describes him as a "true friend." "Chase was the phone call you would always answer and someone who could always provide a laugh or hug when it was needed the most," it reads. It further reveals that the Pope John Paul II Preparatory School student played [basketball](#) and had most recently become the varsity captain. He was also passionate about weightlifting among other creative activities like writing, cooking, traveling, and more. His obituary further reveals that Chase was going to study abroad in England in the upcoming fall semester before his untimely death.

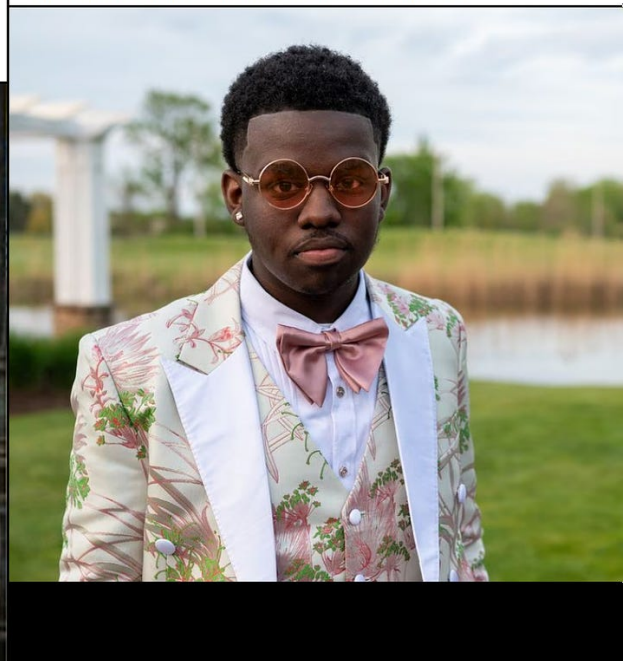
His dad went to wake him up around 2:30 p.m. but couldn't wake him, said his mother, Jennifer Reed.

An ambulance crew worked on him before he was taken to a hospital. He had stopped breathing and there was no brain activity, Reed said. At 3:20 p.m. doctors pronounced him dead.

"He passed away in his sleep. There was no struggle," Reed said. "He wasn't complaining of any pain."

Reed said a medical examiner told the family an infection in his kidneys led to his death.

"It is with heavy hearts that we say goodbye for now to Tyson Downs," posted KW Siskins on Instagram, noting that his passing was "sudden." No information is currently available about how Downs died.

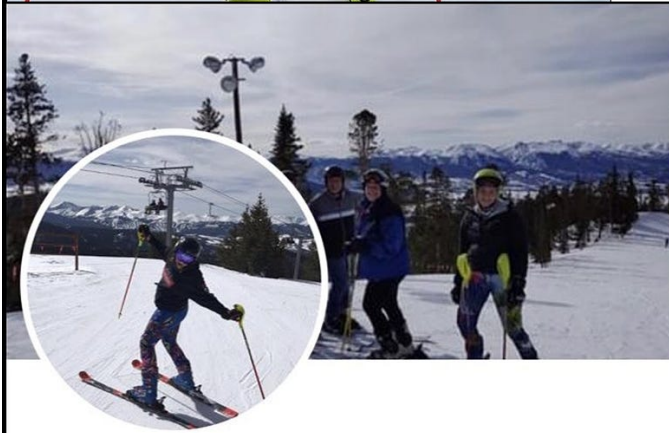

Teen hiker dies while hiking on Kenai Peninsula

A 15-year-old died in Kenai Fjords National Park Monday afternoon while hiking the Harding Icefield trail outside of Seward, according to park officials.

A statement from the national park says the young hiker needed emergency medical services and CPR about 3.7 miles into the trail. It says bystanders helped to provide CPR, and paramedics from a LifeMed helicopter attempted to resuscitate the hiker, but were unsuccessful, and he died on the trail of cardiac arrest.

July 12, 2023 – Fort Moore, Georgia – 19 year old Iowa soldier, Pfc Jacob T Atchison died suddenly during infantry training on July 12, 2023, he had a “medical emergency” (cardiac arrest), received CPR, but was pronounced dead at Army Hospital.

A 19-year-old from Pella suffered a medical emergency during infantry training in Georgia and died on Wednesday.

Pfc. Jacob T. Atchison's death is being investigated, [according to a release](#).

The Army said the medical emergency occurred during training at the Maneuver Center of Excellence at Fort Moore in Georgia. EMS and drill sergeants were notified and began to administer lifesaving procedures. Atchison was then transported to Martin Army Community Hospital where he was pronounced dead shortly after arrival, according to the release.

“We are all deeply saddened by the loss of this outstanding soldier and send our heartfelt condolences to his family,” said Lt. Col. Josh Horner, commander of 3rd Battalion, 47th Infantry Regiment in a statement. “They are in our thoughts and prayers.”

Atchison began Infantry One Unit training on May 12 and was named “Top Shot” for Delta Company, 3rd Battalion, 47th Infantry Regiment, for qualifying as an expert marksman with his weapon the M4, according to the Army.

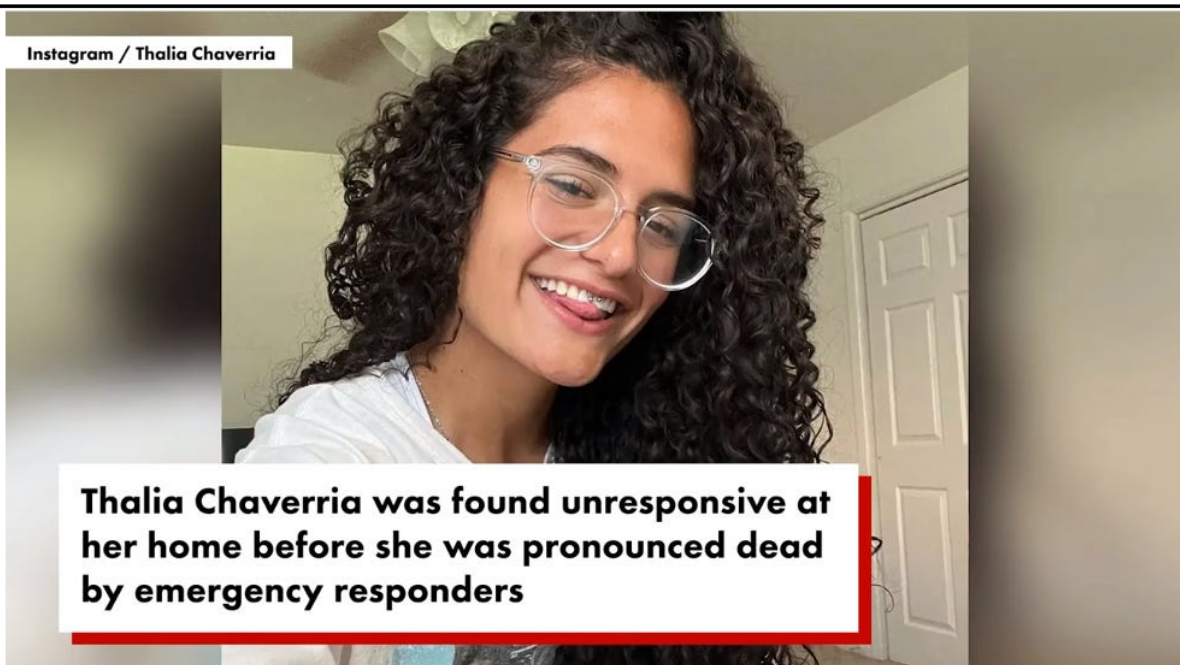

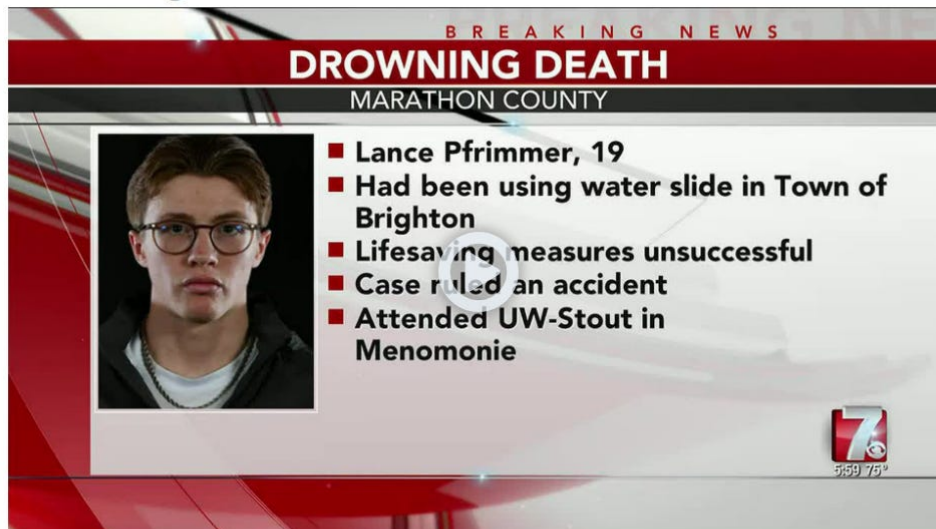

TOWN OF BRIGHTON, Wis. (WSAW) - The Marathon County Sheriff's Department has released information regarding the drowning death of a 19-year-old UW-Stout track student on July 8.

According to police records, Lance Pfrimmer arrived at the 212000 block of Mystic Ave. in the Town of Brighton around 1:30 p.m. by himself from his property in Menominee, though he is originally from Rochester, MN.

He was last seen using a water slide that was on the property's pond between 3:30 and 4 p.m. and was pulled from the water around 6:15 p.m.

Marshfield Fire Department and Spencer Fire Department attempted lifesaving measures but were unsuccessful.

Records show that Pfrimmer, along with approximately 20 other people, were using the large homemade water slide throughout the

A family friend originally told ABC 6 News Pfrimmer's drowning occurred in Menomonee.

However, according to the sheriff's office, deputies responded to the 212,000 block of Mystic Avenue, Brighton, at about 6:17 p.m. July 8, after a party-goer reported that Pfrimmer's body had been pulled from the pond on the property.

About 70 people were attending the party at the residence, according to law enforcement.

Witnesses at the pond described a group of University of Wisconsin-Stout students going down a homemade slide into the pond, after which a woman found Pfrimmer at the bottom of the pond, near the slide.

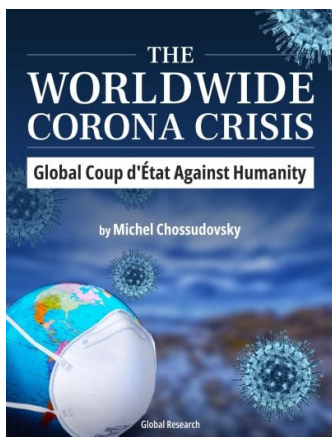
