"There is no doubt that the [improved] technological capabilities [...] can be used for a war on terror in Gaza, for a war in the face of rockets from Lebanon, for war on the conventional Syrian army, and also for war on a peripheral state like Iran." As far as I'm concerned, attack remains the best form of defense [...] There is no doubt, looking at the overall situation, that we are already in a military confrontation with Iran" [Israeli Deputy Prime Minister Moshe Ya'alon, speech to the "Air Power and the Challenges of Israel" conference, Herzliya, Israel, 10 May 2010] [3]
