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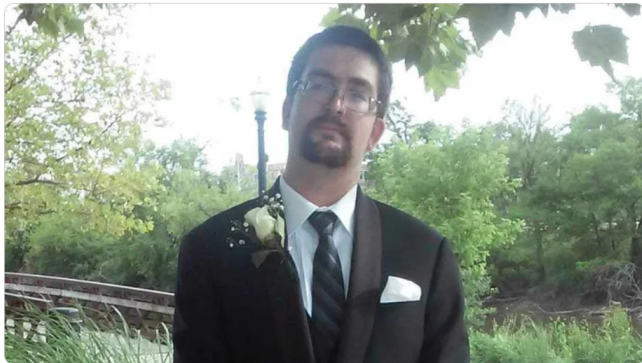
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[Nov.10, 2023](#) - Coal City, IL - 35 year old Chris Hardin was diagnosed with Stage 3 Melanoma in June 2023 that rapidly progressed to Stage 4, didn't respond to radiation or immunotherapy and became Stage 4 with tumor "growing on his spine, pressing on the vertebrae and crushing it while also wrapping around nerves"

In June of this year our family was hit with some of the worst news imaginable, my partner of 12 years Chris, at just 35 years old was diagnosed with Stage 3 Melanoma cancer. Within weeks it became Stage 4 and we have been battling it hard. Immunotherapy, radiation. We thought we could get an handle on this monster but on September 18th Chris was admitted to the hospital due to a decline of grip in both hands and an elevated Heart Rate. After testing they found a tumor had started growing on his spine, pressing on the vertebrae and crushing it, while also wrapping around nerves. He had to undergo surgery to remove both the tumor and some vertebrae, installing two rods and screws to stabilize the spine.

As of last week (Oct 9th) more tumors have been found and Chris is now going through Chemo and dialysis. During all of this Chris hasn't been able to work and we are falling behind on bills and rent. Every last cent donated will be used to keep a home around us,

[Nov.1, 2023](#) – 33 year old Etai David Gamliel was diagnosed with Metastatic Melanoma in late June 2023. It did not respond to radiation or immunotherapy. Cancer spread to spinal cord, taking away his ability to walk, then further up his spine until it took away his ability to breathe.

In late June, our dearly beloved brother, Etai David Gamliel, was diagnosed with Metastatic Melanoma. After going to the emergency room for a severe headache, the doctors had found that the tumors had developed in the temporal lobe of his brain. Etai, with his family, desperately tried to fight this disease, trying every treatment available. Etai was treated at Johns Hopkins Hospital, one of the country's top cancer research centers.

Etai fought tirelessly everyday, going through radiation and immunotherapy. Unfortunately, the cancer he suffered from was very aggressive and known treatment was not working. A young man, at 33 years old, with everything to live for, was robbed of the rest of his life from a disease that took no prisoners. The cancer soon spread to his spinal cord taking away his ability to walk. It then, rapidly moved further up his spine taking his hands, and eventually his ability to breathe. Regardless of all these factors, Etai never gave up or wanted to show weakness in the face of impossible odds. After 4 long months of a taxing emotional and physical rollercoaster, Etai took his last breath on November 1, 2023.

Oct.25, 2023 – Brazil, IN – 28 year old Wesley Miller was going to have some cysts removed from his arm and abdomen. Instead, he was diagnosed with Stage 4 Melanoma with lesions in the brain, lungs, liver and bones.

On September 25th, 2023, Wesley Miller, 28 year old Father of Sophia, Audrey, and Jack. Went to have what we thought were cysts removed from his arm and abdomen. The surgeon, myself, along with 4 other nurses surrounded the recovery room, listening to the Doctor, tell the man that made me a mother, a wife and so much more that Wesley has Cancer. He didn't know what kind, all he said was "could be skin, colon, liver or lung"

October 6, 2023, I am holding Wesley's hand, because today he is being fitted for a mask to hold his head completely still during radiation ...the radiologist goes over his 2nd MRI and his PET scan. I held out for hope as far as good news was concerned. Maybe the surgery cut all the cancer out. Maybe the radiologist could have swung a sledgehammer to our knees?

Wesley and I already brought to our knees just days ago. Radiologist hammer came down to take the rest of our legs leaving us face down on the floor when I asked how long does

Wesley have? "Give or take 6 months, unfortunately this was not caught early." Wesley has Stage IV Metastatic Melanoma, with a 3 - 6 month life expectancy (terminal). It has spread to his brain, lungs, liver, and bones

What we thought were just cysts, turned out to be cancer, what we thought would be a quick in and out procedure has us waiting anxiously for answers, for a plan of action, for

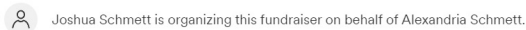
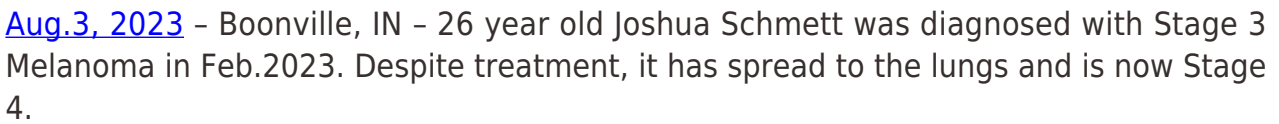
Hello,

I'm a 22-year-old who was on the cusp of an exciting new chapter before life took an unexpected turn. This summer was meant to be the culmination of my master's degree journey, and I had exciting plans to move to New Zealand in September 2023 to embark on a new adventure. A job at a geotechnical engineering firm awaited me, promising a future full of possibilities.


Then came August, a month that changed everything. I was confronted with a diagnosis that none of us ever anticipates – **malignant melanoma (skin cancer)**. Immediate surgery was required, leading to two wide excision surgeries on my back and a sentinel lymph node biopsy, during which two of my lymph nodes were removed. The results were not what I had hoped for – one of those lymph nodes tested positive for melanoma, indicating that the cancer had already begun to spread.

At the moment, I'm facing the challenges of Stage 3B skin cancer, a reality that has put a pause on life. Instead of gearing up for exciting endeavors, I find myself navigating the complexities of treatments, uncertainty, and medical bills.

Aug.11, 2023 – Weedsport, NY – 23 year old Mya Maloof got Stage 4 Melanoma while studying at Nazareth University. When she finished her Masters in Speech Pathology in May, she found out her cancer had spread. She died on Aug.11, 2023 at the age of 23. Her 43 year old mom also has Stage 4 Cancer.

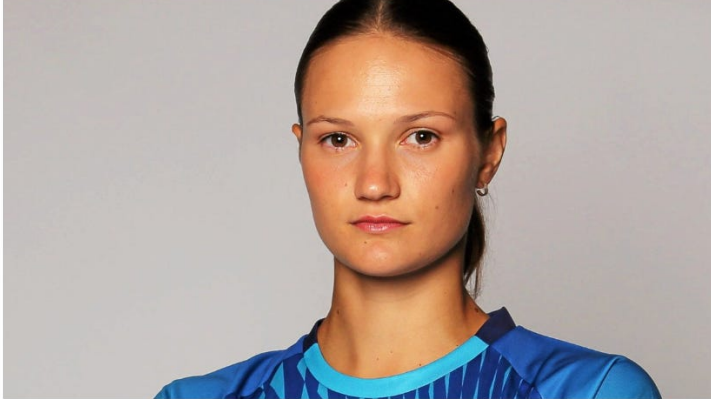

It was June 14th, 2023. We knew she had been at the hospital for chest pains. We also knew that the same week she had located several lumps all over her body, but had not yet been fit in for an ultrasound appointment. (She didn't have an established family doctor yet, as she had left home in BC to move to Calgary in March.)

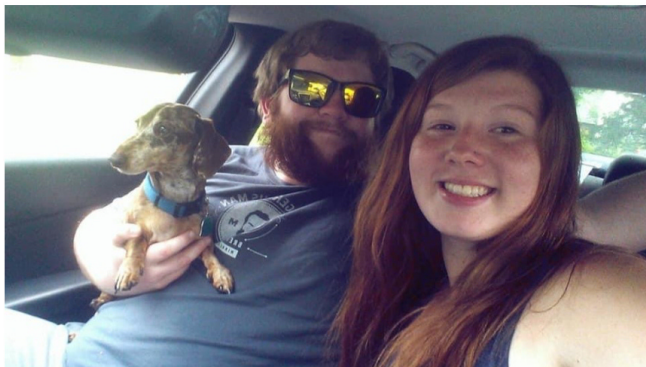
The minute Kaylee called crying from the hospital informing us they had found lesions in her lungs was what we thought would be the scariest day of our life. Mom and I dropped everything immediately and drove overnight to Calgary, and our Dad booked a flight the next morning. We were wrong though, that wasn't the scariest or the worst day... it kept getting worse. By the end of that day, the hospital had found more lesions - in her liver, heart, and brain. Absolutely not what anyone could ever have wanted to discover. We knew then that there was a high likelihood of cancer, but there were a ton more tests to be done first, and what seemed like a cruel lifetime of waiting.

CT scans, MRIs, biopsies, and a lot of anxious waiting led us to a diagnosis we could have never imagined. Stage 4 Metastatic Melanoma.
