



In 2019, at age 32, Dani was diagnosed with aggressive triple-negative breast cancer. She completed 16 rounds of aggressive chemo, followed by a double mastectomy at the Mayo Clinic and then chemo pills for another 6 months. Surgery was successful and the surgeons were able to get clear margins. We were told that Dani was cancer-free. Because of the aggressive treatment plan, we were told we couldn't have any more children.

In 2021 a miracle happened. After years of trying to have more children and then later after the cancer treatment, the Mayo doctors told us we couldn't have children, Dani became pregnant. Lisa was born on May 20th, 2022, a very healthy and happy baby girl who is now 10 months old.

During the pregnancy in 2022, Dani began experiencing a small dry patch of skin on her breast. This dry patch would come and go every couple of weeks. After several months, Dani reached out to her local oncologist to seek advice. Her local oncologist said it did not sound concerning and suggested trying moisturizer. When the moisturizer didn't work, Dani went to the oncologist who again said it doesn't look concerning and that it "didn't look like it needed to be biopsied." At that point, her oncologist referred her to a dermatologist to find an ointment to hopefully help. After trying the ointment for 6 weeks, the dermatologist decided to do a biopsy to make sure they weren't missing anything. Unfortunately, the biopsy came back as cancer.

We decided to go back down to the Mayo Clinic for a 2nd opinion and upon further scans, they found that there is a mass embedded into Dani's chest wall. This was heartbreaking news. The Mayo doctors hadn't seen this happen before and weren't sure how to proceed at first. After meeting to discuss Dani's case, her Mayo doctors decided on a treatment plan that includes 12 weekly rounds of chemo infusions, followed by specialized radiation for 5 weeks at the Mayo to avoid damage to her heart as much as possible, and lastly a very aggressive surgery to remove a section of her chest wall, including the pectoral muscle and 4-inch sections from two ribs. The reconstruction will be an extremely difficult and long process.

<u>Sep. 19, 2023</u> – Denton, TX – Amanda Anderson-Barberis was diagnosed with Stage 4 breast cancer while pregnant with her 3rd child, and died when he was 9 months old.

Lindsey's Story:

In early November of 2022, Lindsey and Kurtis were very excited to find out that Lindsey was pregnant, and they were ready to start their family. Unfortunately, Lindsey found out weeks later that she had a miscarriage. During this time, Lindsey had noticed a lump on her breast. She informed her doctor multiple times of this lump, but it was chalked up to a swollen lymph node, likely from her pregnancy. Lindsey knew that something else was wrong and, being an advocate for

herself pushed for further testing and answers.

Following an ultrasound, MRI, and biopsy, Lindsey's worst fears were confirmed. She was officially diagnosed with stage III triple-negative ductal carcinoma, on February 6, 2023.

Lindsey started her first round of chemotherapy at the University of Minnesota Masonic Center just days later as time was of the essence. The plan for Lindsey so far is to have 16 rounds of chemotherapy, followed by a double mastectomy, axillary lymph node dissection,

Kelly Ross, 39, from Sunderland is taking part in a new research project that will help women to make healthy lifestyle choices after breast cancer treatment.

Funded by research and support charity Breast Cancer Now, researchers at Newcastle University will develop a programme that aims to improve women's access to nutrition and physical activity support once their breast cancer treatment is completed.

Kelly was diagnosed with grade three oestrogen receptor positive (ER-positive) breast cancer in October 2022, while 28 weeks pregnant with her son Rudy, now six months.

To ensure that Kelly could start chemotherapy as soon as possible, clinicians suggested she should be admitted to hospital so the birth could be induced at 38 weeks.

Kelly completed her chemotherapy in May 2023 and has been keen to rebuild her strength through exercising.

June 25, 2023 – Rutledge, GA – Karen Vincent had health problems during pregnancy, her baby was delivered at 26 weeks by C-section and she was found to have Stage 4 breast cancer with metastases to bones, liver and brain.

At the age of 28, Sami was driving home from work when she got the phone call that the biopsy came back as invasive ductal breast cancer. Shortly after the diagnosis, she underwent a double mastectomy for her Stage 1 cancer because of her BRCA 1 gene mutation. Her team decided that was a very aggressive approach and she would be good to go. Not even a year later (286 days to be exact) she was diagnosed with a local recurrence again at stage 1. She underwent a partial mastectomy, chemo and radiation. She had an amazing 2 years getting back into her new normal and trying not to let every ache, pain and checkup get the best of her. Life after a cancer diagnosis is no joke. Things got scary again fast after she got pregnant with her miracle baby, Lyla, (a pregnancy the Dr's said couldn't happen due to hormone blockers and chemo Sami had been on since her first diagnosis in 2019). She was admitted to the ICU with a collapsed lung, quickly learning that her cancer was back at age 31. This time it had metastasized to her lungs, liver, and bone. She underwent more chemo this time with the cocktail that most call the "Red Devil", but I told my sister we will call it "Jesus wine" because the devil has no place in your story!

May 23, 2023 - Lawton, OK - Rocki Novotny was diagnosed with Stage 3 breast cancer the size of a lime and metastatic lymph nodes throughout her body in May 2022. She suspects she had developed cancer while pregnant with her baby whom she delivered in Nov. 2021.

Just hours apart on August 16th, 2022, Tammy found out she was pregnant with her fifth child and had breast cancer. They were excited about the thought of another baby, but fear quickly swept in learning about her breast cancer. Their world was turned upside down, as you could imagine. After several tests, ultrasounds, and Dr. appointments, a safe plan was in place to treat her during pregnancy. Unfortunately, at nine weeks, she had a heartbreaking missed miscarriage which required a D & C. Ryan and Tammy love their children dearly, and this was so hard to endure, in addition to her breast cancer diagnosis.

Treatment plans have now changed for her aggressive breast cancer. She had her first chemo treatment on Tuesday, October 4th. She will complete five more treatments every three weeks until the middle of January 2023. Then she will have a double mastectomy with expanders placed the same day, followed by 34 weeks of additional treatment, including radiation, and recontruction. She'll also be doing 5-10 years of hormone blockers., including a total hysterectomy as soon as her oncologist approves the surgery after the breast cancer treatment. She will have to face 4+ surgeries in the coming months.

With permission from Kim and Chris, I have started this fundraiser on behalf of my brother and sister-in-law as they face their biggest battle yet. On February 14th, 2023, Kim received the devastating diagnosis that she has breast cancer - just two short months after welcoming their newest addition to their family. She has been diagnosed with invasive ductal carcinoma, ER+ PR+ HER2+. While her cancer is aggressive, we are so grateful for the recent advances in medicine that allow doctors to know the right treatment that will target this specific cancer. Due to her cancer being triple positive, Kim has already undergone extensive testing and procedures immediately after her diagnosis. She has begun chemotherapy with multiple treatments and surgeries in the future. Any donations for their family will be used to cover costs incurred from Kim's treatment and to keep life as normal as possible for their young children, Brooklyn (8 years old) and Jace (2 months old). Kim has been so brave as she faces this battle - below is her story in her own words:

Two and a half weeks before Jace was born Chris and I were relaxing on the couch late one Saturday night and to this day I have no idea what made me feel my left breast. I wasn't having pain or anything, I just put my arm up and did my own little self-check. I felt a tiny lump... I was a little concerned but also knew that pregnancy causes many changes in the body. I had a regular pregnancy checkup scheduled a few days later and mentioned it to my gynecologist. They did a breast exam and then had me schedule an ultrasound. The ultrasound came back with suspicious findings and I was referred for a biopsy. In the midst of all of this, I gave birth and just tried my best to enjoy being a mom to a newborn again and enjoying our new family of 4. It was honestly the happiest I had ever been. Fast forward to weeks later after having another ultrasound, a mammogram and a biopsy (my 1 lump was now 3). I had a follow-up with a surgical oncologist on Valentine's Day to go over my results, and that's when I received my diagnosis. In the following weeks up until now I've had many different appointments and tests (and still have more upcoming tests scheduled). I got set up with my oncologist who has been great. Due to my cancer being triple positive and aggressive, she wanted me to start chemo treatment right away. So this past Monday (2 months to the day I went in for my induction to have Jace) I started chemo. Then on Wednesday, I went in for surgery to have a port placed for future treatments. So much has been happening and this is all honestly my worst nightmare come true. Some things I know so far: I will lose all of my hair soon, I will have a double mastectomy and a possible hysterectomy (waiting on my genetic test results). I'm still processing it all but I am choosing to stay as positive as I possibly can.

I am 38 and mammograms aren't recommended until 40. My advice is to be proactive and

My Take...

Cancer during pregnancy is rare and before COVID-19 mRNA vaccines approximately 1:1000 pregnancies were complicated by maternal cancer.

Of these, breast cancer is most common, corresponding to between 1:3000 to 1:10000 pregnancies, according to a 2022 Dutch study by Boere et al.

COVID-19 mRNA Vaccines are causing Turbo Cancers in young people and breast cancer is in the top 3 most common cancers caused by Pfizer or Moderna mRNA.

Since 2021, there are far more Stage 3 and Stage 4 Breast cancers being diagnosed in pregnant women. They are present in GoFund me in 2020 and prior but in much smaller numbers.

The key question I ask is:

- Are these Stage 3 and 4 Breast cancers in pregnancy just a reflection of skyrocketing Turbo Cancers in COVID-19 mRNA vaccinated reproductive age women, or
- 2. Does pregnancy itself increase the risk of Turbo Cancer manifesting in a COVID-19 mRNA Vaccinated woman? (In other words, would the same woman still have gotten Stage 3 or 4 breast cancer, at the same point in time, if she hadn't gotten pregnant?)

I don't know the answer.

Furthermore, Triple Negative breast cancer (the worst prognosis), seems to be the most common subtype of Turbo Breast Cancer (whether in pregnancy or not).

Oncologists should be studying these questions, unfortunately selling mRNA vaccines for Pfizer & Moderna shareholders pays much better, and keeps their licenses, academic promotions, and grant funding safe and sound.


