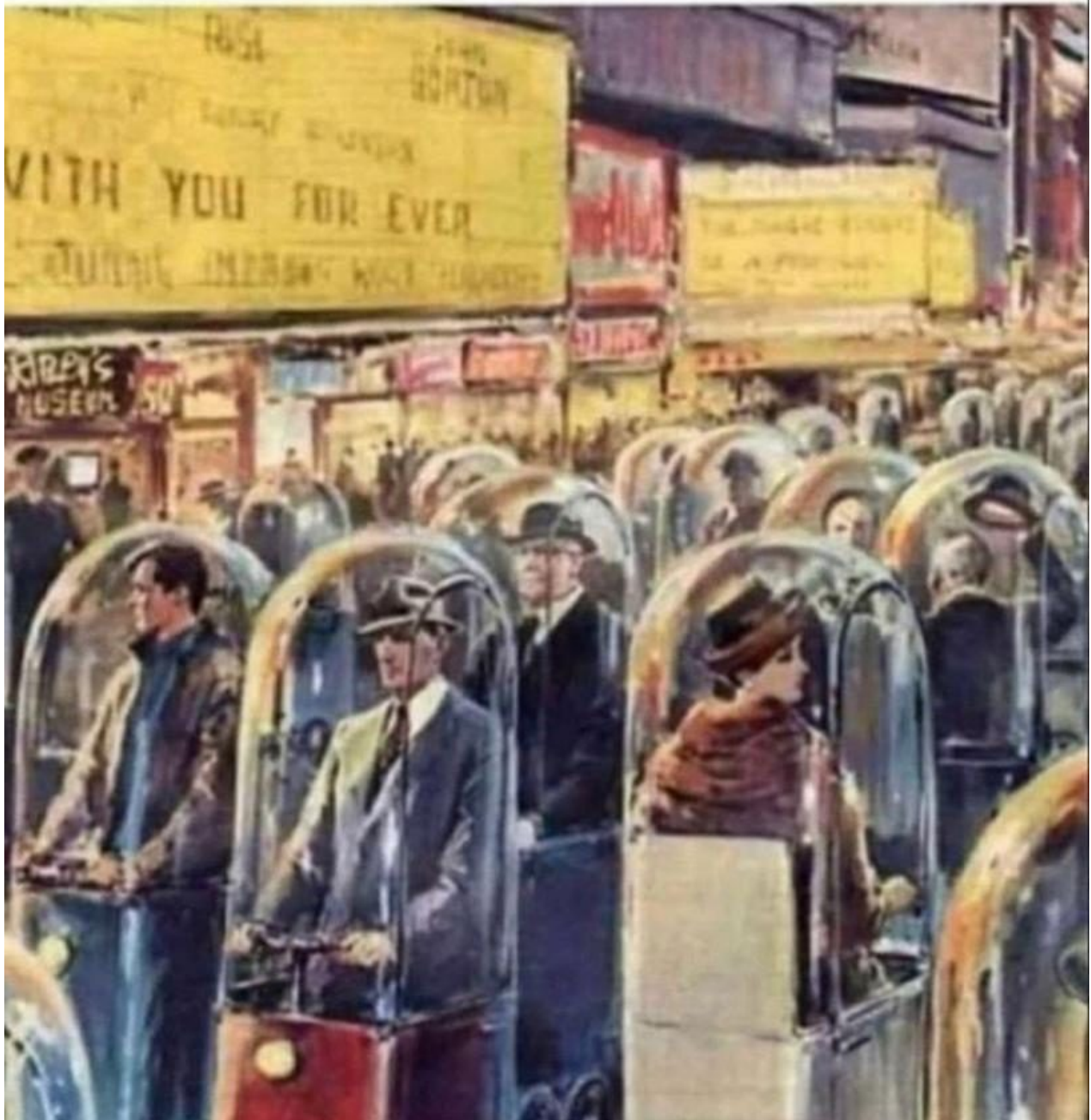
*This painting by Italian artist Walter Molino was published in the Italian newspaper La Domenica del Corriere in 1962.*
