


In late 2021 and early 2022, teachers were mandated to take COVID-19 vaccines, or they faced losing their jobs and their entire teaching careers.

These 15 sudden deaths are just examples of what happened to some of those teachers.

Feb.17, 2023 – Oneonta, NY – SUNY Oneonta professor, teacher and interpreter for the Deaf, died suddenly on Feb.17, 2023, 7 days after her 4th COVID-19 vaccine.



Feb. 15, 2023 – Cambridge, MA – 29 year old MIT math professor Peter Baddoo died suddenly on Feb.15, 2023 while playing basketball on campus.



Feb. 12, 2023 – MN – 46 year old James Jim McKeon, Bemidji High School Football assistant coach died suddenly of cardiac arrest while ice fishing with his 10 year old son (<u>click here</u>).



James "Jim" Charles McKeon, 46, of Bemidji, MN died unexpectedly on Sunday, February 12, 2023. Jim was ice fishing with his 10-year-old son Rocco and a friend on Mantrap Lake in Nevis, MN when he collapsed from an apparent and sudden cardiac arrest. Rocco attempted life-saving measures, but even paramedics were unable to revive him.




Feb. 10, 2023 – 59 year old Mary Ouderkirk, 3rd grade teacher at Elizabeth Cady Stanton Elementary School in Seneca Falls School district died suddenly (<u>click here</u>).

Feb. 10, 2023 – Ireland – High School teacher Aidan Walsh died suddenly. No cause of death given. (<u>click here</u>).

A 19-year-old kids swimming teacher described as a "kind and caring" girl and a "model employee" has died after suffering a cardiac arrest.

Mia Jennings helped hundreds of children learn to swim at her local pool at Macclesfield Leisure Centre, in the Cheshire town.

Jan. 18, 2023 - Mukwonago, WI - Gregory Aprahamian died suddenly on Jan.18, 2023 "due to an enlarged heart". He was a highly respected teacher and wrestling coach at Muskego and Kettle Moraine Schools.



Greg died suddenly on January 18, 2023, due to an enlarged heart. Greg was married to the love of his life, Tammy (Iverson) Aprahamian for 34 happy years. He was the proud father of Brittany (Dan) Dubnicka Aprahamian, Ryan (Daysi) Aprahamian, Tyler Aprahamian, and Megan (Dan) Edwards. He was ecstatic to be Grandpa to Raylee Hope (22 months old), Maxton Gregory (14 months old), and Andrew Roger (almost 8 months old). Greg is additionally survived by his mother, Patricia Aprahamian, his brothers, George, Leonard, Steve, Charles, and Michael. He is preceded in death by his father, Dr. Charles Aprahamian and his mother-in-law, Bonita Iverson. Greg was a highly respected eacher and wrestling coach for over 30 years at Muskego and Kettle Moraine Schools. <mark>He</mark> was a positive influence on the lives of many of his students and wrestlers as well as a mentor to so many others. As head coach, Greg led Muskego to a team state title in 1994. Wrestling was a family affair as Greg coached both his sons, and his daughters were team managers, at Mukwonago High School. He also coached football and track through the years, but wrestling was always his passion. Even in "retirement," he kept himself more than busy. He invested in properties in Whitewater and made great strides in revitalizing the downtown area. He also kept building onto his dream house on the lake. Even with all that, he always found time to help with his children's home renovations. Whenever he could relax, Greg loved swimming in the lake, playing fetch with his dogs, and going to his condo in Ormond Beach, Florida. He was an avid Wisconsin sports fan and enjoyed having a beer and watching the Packers, Badgers, Bucks and Brewers. Greg accomplished many things, but anyone that knew him could tell that he was most proud of being a grandfather. He loved his three grandkids more than anything and was looking forward to spending as much time with them as he could. Garner High School teacher unexpectedly dies 3 days after being suspended, according to Wake County Public School System

Jake Stevens was a career and technical education teacher at Garner Magnet High School. Stevens died Monday night, just three days after he was suspended.

GARNER, N.C. – A Garner Magnet High School teacher died Monday night, the school's principal wrote in a letter to families.

Jake Stevens was a career and technical education (CTE) teacher at GMHS for 16 years and a graduate of the school, according to Principal Matt Price's letter.

"It is with great sadness that I write this note to let you know that one of our CTE Teachers, Jake Stevens, died last night, unexpectedly," Price wrote in a letter to families. "Our condolences, thoughts and prayers go out to his family and his friends and coworkers."

The Wake County Public School System said Stevens was suspended with pay on Jan. 13, days before his death.

There is no known connection between his suspension and death. Stevens' cause of death is not known at this time.

Jan. 13, 2023 – Lewiston, ME – 59 year old Lewiston Middle School math teacher Tim Strohm, died from an unspecified "sudden medical event".

Tim Strohm, a math teacher on Team Haleakala, died from a sudden medical event Friday, according to a message from Superintendent Jake Langlais.



According to Iredell-Statesville Schools, Chris Davis was performing field maintenance on the school's campus on Tuesday when he suffered a medical emergency.

First responders were called to the school and attempted to resuscitate Davis, but to no avail.

Davis had served as a volunteer coach at South Iredell for more than six years.



Christopher VanDarren Davis, 48, of Statesville, N.C., died Tuesday, January 10, 2023, doing one of the things he loved best, tending the baseball diamond at South Iredell High School.

Jan. 5, 2023 – San Antonio, TX – 35 yo Middle School coach Jacob Sanchez collapsed in class & died suddenly. Principal was with him minutes before he collapsed: "He seemed fine and everything seemed fine," she said.




Jacob Sanchez made an everlasting impact on his students and loved ones

Jan. 5, 2023 – Benbrook, TX – 47 year old Western Hills High School principal James Wellman died unexpectedly.


FWISD PRINCIPAL JAMES WELLMAN DIES UNEXPECTEDLY

Looking at these 15 tragic deaths of teachers, ages 19 to 59:


- 1 died in sleep
